Speedwatch

During February through to March 5 we held 3 sessions and 5 vehicles were reported to the Police for exceeding 35 mph. We had 100% accuracy in reporting this month. The fastest reported speed was 52 mph which was almost the maximum we have recorded (that was 53 mph) which is 73% over the limit. The driver will receive a letter from the Police and information stored for 12 months in Kent Police records for 12 months. In addition 1 letter sent for second offence and 1 driver logged for first offence.

It should be noted that 30 minutes before the offence a horse plus rider was seen with another horse in tow. Just imagine the carnage if this driver had hit these animals.
